



The Absolutely Fresh Seafood Family of stores and restaurants has been honored to provide charitable donations to many local organizations, groups, and churches over the years as a way of giving back to the community that supports us, as well as being able to assist those in need. While we ideally would help out anyone who asks, we often must make difficult decisions in granting requests. In order for us to help out as many worthy causes as possible, we have created this guide to help with the process.

Donation requests may include the following:

- Gift Card Donations (Valid at all of our locations)
- Dollar for Dollar Gift Card Match (Buy \$10.00, get \$10.00 free, limits apply)
- Product Donations
- First Tuesday Fundraiser Recipients (10-12 month Advance Request)

As of March 15th 2019, we request that all donation requests must be received in writing via email, U.S. Mail, or in person (with paper copy explaining request and charity) during regular business hours at Absolutely Fresh Seafood Market at 1218 S. 119th by the 20th of any given month. We will then review all requests received, and choose which requests will be granted based on certain criteria (see below).

We will notify those organizations whose requests have been approved by the last day of the month in which the submission term ends. Donations will then be available to be picked up in person from the above address. Any requests received past the deadline will be considered for the following month, however, we will not grant donation requests for events occurring more four (4) months out from the time of the request.

While we encourage all worthy organizations to apply, the following considerations will be made in the decision making process:

1. For-profit, government/political related organizations, social clubs, national charities, and requests for groups/events outside of the immediate Omaha metro area will not be considered.
2. Frequency of requests from any given organization is considered. Requests will not be granted for any one organization, church, or school more than once a quarter in any given year.
3. Groups must be specific as to what the funds are being used to benefit. Requests that directly benefit the less fortunate, health/crisis benefits, and social programs helping human and animal interests or disabled individuals will receive higher consideration.
4. The amount of and type of request (please be specific as possible).
5. The recognition received for the donation
